The assignments feel really disconnected from the course material, they are much more challenging, so maybe if there was a way to keep 2 of the challenging ones, but have 3 or 4 easier ones to get people started on the right foot. What i think the main problem is, people see how hard the first assignment is because we are still barely grasping a new language and resort to outside help to do it for them and then fall behind.
Grading/assignment feedback would benefit from being a little more clear.
