Now and each of them Wills granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, enfeoffed, and confirmed and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, enfeoffed and confirmed unto the said Ronald M^c Donald his heirs and assigns all that certain lot of land situated and being in Brown's Mountain in the County of Antigonish aforesaid and bounded as follows that is to say on the north by lands now occupied by Margaret M^c Donald, Catherine M^c Donald and Christina M^c Donald and on the east by lands of the heirs of the late John M^c Gillivray and on the south by lands of James M^c Gee; and on the west by lands of the heirs of the late John M^c Donald containing ninety acres more or less together with all and singular the buildings, and erections thereon ways, water, watercourses, easements, commodities, privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way appertaining and the reversions and reversions, remainders, rents, issues, and profits thereof and also the right, title, estate, interest, claim
