This Agreement entered into at Newbury in the County  
 of Suffolk and the Province of Massachusetts on the fourth day  
 of January One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen between  
 the Reverend Alexander McDonald and the Reverend  
 the Case and Surgeon. Whereas of the Back Settlers  
 most of Newbury on the other that the said  
 and in Consideration of Two Hundred and Fifty Pounds lawful  
 Money of the Province to be paid in the manner herein  
 after described, the said Surgeon doth warrant to the said  
 Alexander McDonald, his heirs and Assigns that he doth  
 hereby agree to bargain and sell unto the said Surgeon

the following lots and tracts of land situate lying and  
 being at Newbury in the County and Province aforesaid, that is to say  
 half a Number One in the third Range half a Number One in the fourth  
 Range and half a Number Two in the third Range half a Number Two in  
 the fourth Range and half a Number Three in the third Range of One  
 Hundred Acres each of which three aforesaid containing in the whole  
 five half Acres and it is agreed as follows

And the said Surgeon doth warrant to the said  
 Alexander McDonald here by  
 a good bill to pay for the said land the sum of two Hundred and Fifty  
 Pounds lawful Money of this Province as follows that is to say  
 Fifty Pounds at the signing of these presents Fifty Pounds on the first  
 day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen Fifty Pounds on  
 the first day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixteen Fifty Pounds

Range are not to be taken on the said Range, all the same two in  
the fourth Range and last number three in the third Range of one  
hundred acres each of which are reserved containing in the whole  
one hundred and twenty acres more or less.

And the above mentioned Angus M. Buchanan here by  
agrees to pay for the said land the sum of two hundred and fifty  
Pounds lawful Money of this Province, as follows, that is to say  
fifty Pounds at the signing of these Presents, fifty Pounds on the first  
day of November One Thousand Eight Hundred and fifteen, fifty Pounds on  
the first day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and sixteen, fifty Pounds  
on the first day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and seventeen and  
fifty Pounds on the first day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and  
eighteen being at two hundred and equal payments and the said  
Alexander M. Donald for and in consideration of this sum hereby binds  
himself his Heirs Administrators Executors and Assigns to give to the  
said Angus M. Buchanan, his Heirs Administrators Executors and Assigns  
on the first day of May One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighteen, being  
the day in which the last payment shall have been made a good and  
sufficient Deed of the said Lots of lands. In Witness whereof the parties
