Witnesseth that the said Ronald McDonald for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and sixty eight dollars lawful money of Nova Scotia to him in hand by the said Augustus Easheen well and truly paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. hath granted bargained sold assigned transferred, enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell assign transfer enfeoff release and confirm unto the said Augustus Easheen his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right title interest claim proper and demand at law or in equity which he the said Ronald McDonald now has or may or can hereafter have of in to upon or out of all that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being at Brasens Mountain aforesaid and bounded as follows First that portion of said lot which is embraced in the Tenth Range of Hartshorn Grant so called and bounded as follows, that is to say toward the north by lands of John McDonald, toward the East by lands now in the possession of said Ronald McDonald, toward the South by the Southern boundary of said Tenth Range and toward the West by lands of John and Allan McDonald containing eighty seven more or less, secondly that portion of it embraced in the eleventh range of said Hartshorn Grant and bounded as follows, that is to say, toward the north by the Southern boundary of the aforesaid Tenth Range of said Hartshorn Grant, toward the East by lands of Ronald and Augustus McDonald, toward the South by the Southern boundary of said Eleventh Range and toward
