

CERTIFICATE OF PURCHASE

THIS CERTIFIES that on the 10 day of June, A.D., 1980, the following property, being all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at Browns Mountain, in the County of Antigonish, Province of Nova Scotia, assessed as "Owner Unknown" on the assessment rolls of the Municipality of the County of Antigonish, vested absolutely in Her Majesty the Queen in the Right of the Province of Nova Scotia, pursuant to Section 157A of the Assessment Act, Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia 1967, as amended by Chapter 18 of the Statutes of Nova Scotia 1978, which property is more particularly bounded and described as follows:

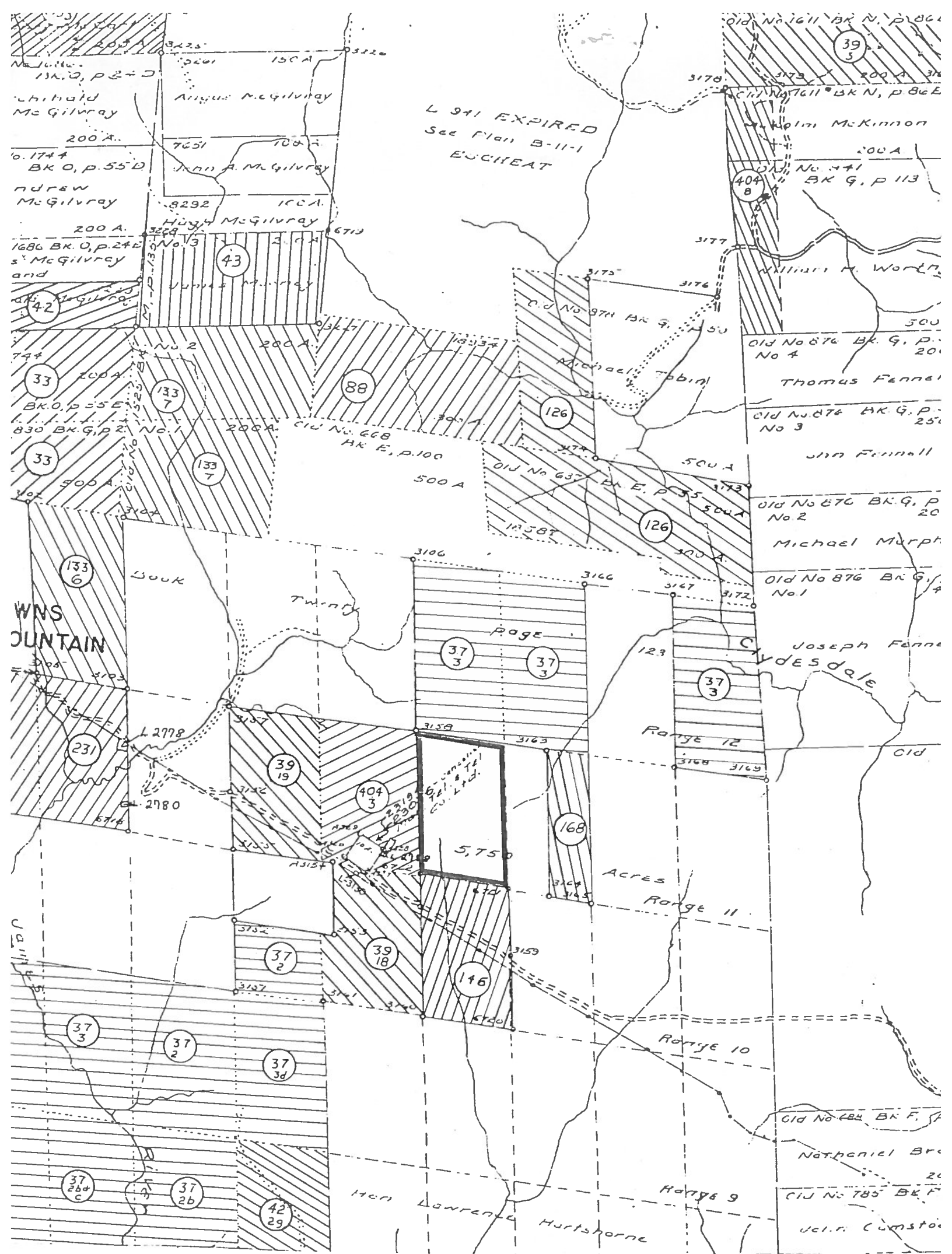
