TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This Is To Certify under Section 16A of the said Act that I, the undersigned, the Attorney General in and for the Province of Nova Scotia, acting as the Minister of Lands and Forests in and for the said Province, do hereby declare forfeited the said lands which are more particularly described as follows:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being on the west side of Liscomb Harbor in the County of Guysboro, Province of Nova Scotia, and bounded and described as follows: Beginning at the southwestern shore of Liscomb Harbor at the north-eastern bounds of Simon McDonald's land; thence southwesterly along the line between the lands of Simon McDonald and the lands of David Langille to the rear of said Simon McDonald's land; thence northwesterly to the north corner of lands granted to George Smith; thence south twenty nine degrees east one hundred and flfteen chains to the lands of Joseph P. Miller and others; thence along the northern line of Judan P. Miller's lands easterly to Liscomb Point: there northerly along the western line of Miller's lands to Smoky Point; thence westerly along the southern line of lands of Charles Riley and others to the southwest corner of lands of Eli Misener; thence northerly by the line between the lands of Eli Misener and the Lunds of David Langille to the southwest shore of Liscomb Harbor; thence westerly along said shore to the place of beginning and containing three thousand acres more or less.
